Trustland Plan Overview

- Goal 1 – Effective Interventions
 - o Hired an Americorp Technician – Amy Gibson
 - Works with kids that need some added intervention
- Goal 2 – Professional Development
 - o Teachers improve best practices- sending teachers to conferences, substitutes, transportation if needed
- Goal 3 – Technology
 - o In great shape – every core class has either a lab or a chromebook lab

- 9th graders for their own chromebooks? – District did not let them go through, because there is a small group in Diamond Fork Junior that goes to Spanish Fork High
 - Science, Fine Arts has chromebooks bought this year
 - Interns got some used chromebooks for their classes
 - Big concerns with replacing chromebooks as they get worn out over time
 - Good news is that we don't have to worry about carts in the future
 - New classrooms in place – need to add document cameras, sound systems
- Goal 4 – Reduce Class Sizes
 - Interns – 3 paid through Trustlands
- Trustland funds are about 120,000 dollars this year
 - Moving forward we need to be concerned about using Trustlands for salary
