- Review of upcoming year. Projection for numbers and master scheduling -

-1140 students based on boundary change (down from 1260)

February board meeting will be voted on

-Lose 4-5 FTE (full time enrollment)

-Still in waiting mode based on board vote.

-Master schedule is in process as offerings for 8-9th graders

-End of January will begin scheduling current students then based on board vote others will be registered.

Current year funding

-Student advocates -\$30,000

-Chromebooks-\$63,800

-Other technology-\$20,000

Question about TSSA funding- New money and should be around for future funding. District holds onto some of that money for funding teacher development and new programs

- Review of current Trustland spending and discussion

Current year funding

-FTE -\$120,000

-Chromebooks-\$29,000

-PD-\$10,000

Will need to look at School Improvement Plan, SIP. Our current plans fits into the SIP very well.

- Review of upcoming needs

-Chromebooks

-We need to decide between 1 to 1 or carts in classrooms

-We ordered 325 for this current year. (9 carts)

-We need to replace 22 carts in the next 2 years

-11 carts in 2021- 396 chromebooks

-12 carts on 2022 -432 chromebooks

-Total chromebooks by 2022 = 1153

Discussion - Parents like having one for each student

-Students have become better at bringing chromebooks and having them charged.

-Can use some of the PD money to help compensate for the cost of new chromebooks.

Question come back about keeping chromebooks until the end of high school- it is being looked at in the district

-Will likely need to pay for 2 additional FTE to maintain class size
