Current year funding

-FTE -\$120,000 so far \$118,000

-Chromebooks-\$29,000 so far \$

-PD-\$10,000 most is going to carryover as PD and conferences have not been held

Proposal for coming year with a decrease in students

-FTE \$100,000 used to keep class sizes down.

-Chromebooks- technology \$29,000

Professional development- \$25,000

Math mentoring- Parents comments were very positive about this program and have missed it this year.

Discussion about using different types of technology. Mainly chromebooks versus Surface.
