-Welcome from Mr. Loveless

-Introductions- Each member introduced themselves.

-Discussion on meeting format and parliamentary procedures-Reviewed the parliamentary procedures template from the state.

-Chairperson nominations-Nominations were opened for chairperson. Shanni Call nominated Julie Johnson as chairman, seconded by Jami Branch. No discussion, vote was unanimous. -Discussion on meeting times and dates-Nomination was made by Jami Branch to hold SCC meeting on the 3rd Wednesday of the month @ 12:30 pm. It was seconded by Julie Branch. The voting was unanimous.

-Review of this year's trust land plan-Reviewed what was submitted. Changed from several goals to one main goal that we can use actions plans plans. TSSA- Money allocated to help student improvements. Plan goes to the school board for approval.

3 main areas

1 - FTE is the biggest expense from trustlands- Mainly in Math and Science and also an English intern.

2- Technology- amended more money to technology. Purchased 350 chromebooks, could be other technology.

3- Professional development - training for teachers.

Discussion on smart projectors, "I"-ready for English teachers to help with assessments and concepts that are missed. We have 3 student advocates (trackers) have also been hired and do work with students in 4 study hall classes and pulling students who need help with classes. Questions about classroom sound systems, how students with Cochlear implants are doing in class. Another question about the FTE system and how it determines how many teachers are in the building.

Question about funding.

Trustlands expect \$150,000.
TSSA money is expected to be \$80,000.

-School Accreditation This year will be an accreditation year. We have 9th graders so we will have to go through this process. Mrs. LeMmon explained what is involved and the expectations for this process. This year will be a remote meeting. It will include a 3 day zoom type of process. It will be in mid March. Parent and teacher surveys will be used. Some parents may be asked to be involved. Some teachers will be asked to be a part of other school accreditation to be better prepared for our own accreditation.
