1. **Welcome / Introductions**
2. **Review of Previous Meeting Minutes**
 - Vote of approval of the minutes by Whitney Hancock, 2nd by Amy Baird
3. **School Celebrations**
 - 1st Term Grades: Over 75% of our students earned a 3.0 GPA or higher
 - Fall Sports Recap (Girls Tennis, Cross Country)

 - Discussed the designs and features of the new Spanish Fork High School.

 - Reviewed what have been implemented to help support our Multi-Lingual students.
